What you need to know about TIFSS

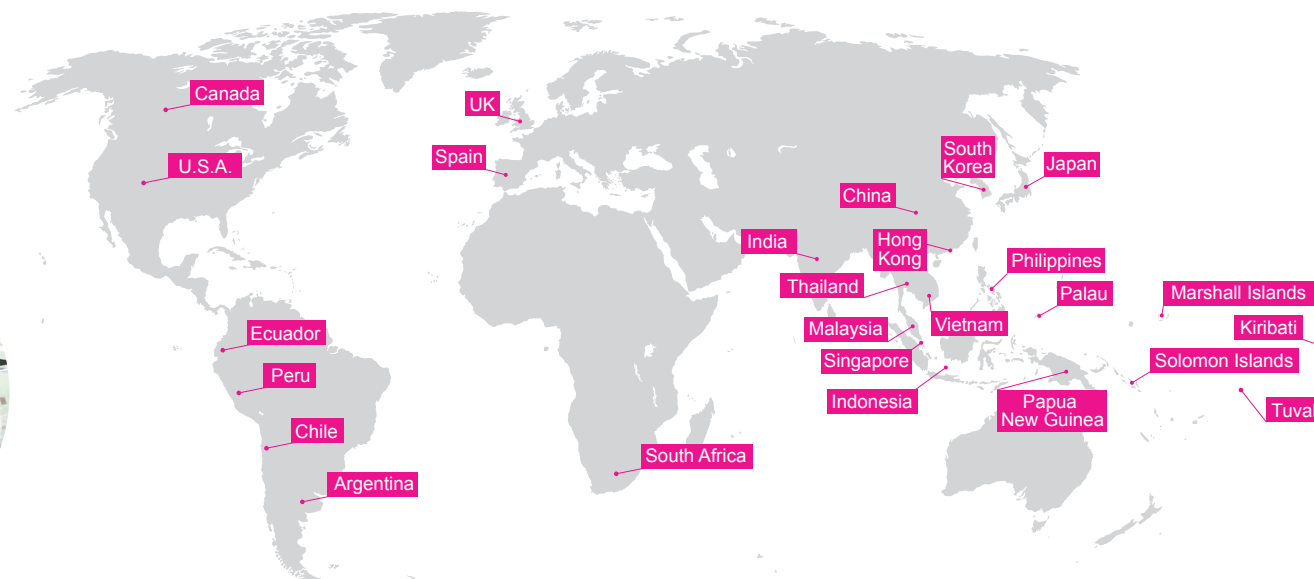
The 4th TIFSS will provide an all-encompassing and exclusive fishery trade show gathering representatives from private-sector, research institutes, academia and government.

Taiwan Fishery Industry Overview

New business opportunities emerge in advancing the fishery industry.

Taiwan is a maritime nation. In recent years, new business opportunities have derived from the need to upgrade the fishery industry in areas including fish hatchery, technologies in artificial tuna sea-ranching, and combining traditional fishing with leisure. This has resulted in an increased demand on brood fish, aquaculture equipment and leisure fishery.

Taiwan's diversified food appetite and per capita seafood consumption is 1.7 times higher than the world average, making the island one of Asia's greatest potential markets.

Taiwan's importation of fishery products showed a steady annual growth of 3% in recent years. As Taiwanese people love to eat seafood, the demand for variety and high-value seafood has grown. Major imported fishery products include shrimp, lobster, crab, salmon and minced fish. Taiwan's main seafood import countries include China, Norway, Japan, Vietnam, Indonesia, Chile, Thailand, India, the US and Nicaragua.

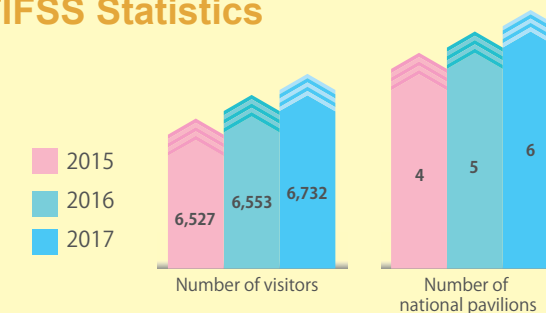
Exclusive Marketing Campaigns & Events
