PATAGONIA EXTREMA

Bodega Otronia is the **southernmost vineyard** and winery of the world.

It is located in the heart of Patagonia on **parallel 45'33**, which is probably the last southern frontier for cultivating vines.

Avinea group analyzed the possibility to grow vines from 2008 and established 50 Has of from 2013.

Vineyards were mainly planted with Chardonnay, Pinot Grigio, Gewürztraminer and Pinot Noir.

The soil is **calcareous**; permanent winds and dry climate guarantees **disease-free** organic grape production.

Top of the art winemaking equipment were installed in 2017.
The construction of the winery is planned for 2021.

First vintage will be released on April 2019.
