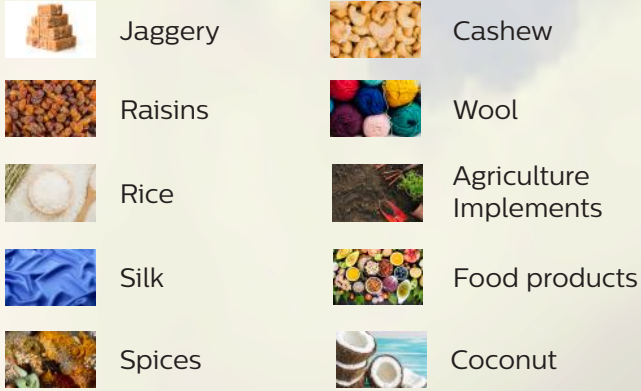
Indian food processing industry highlights

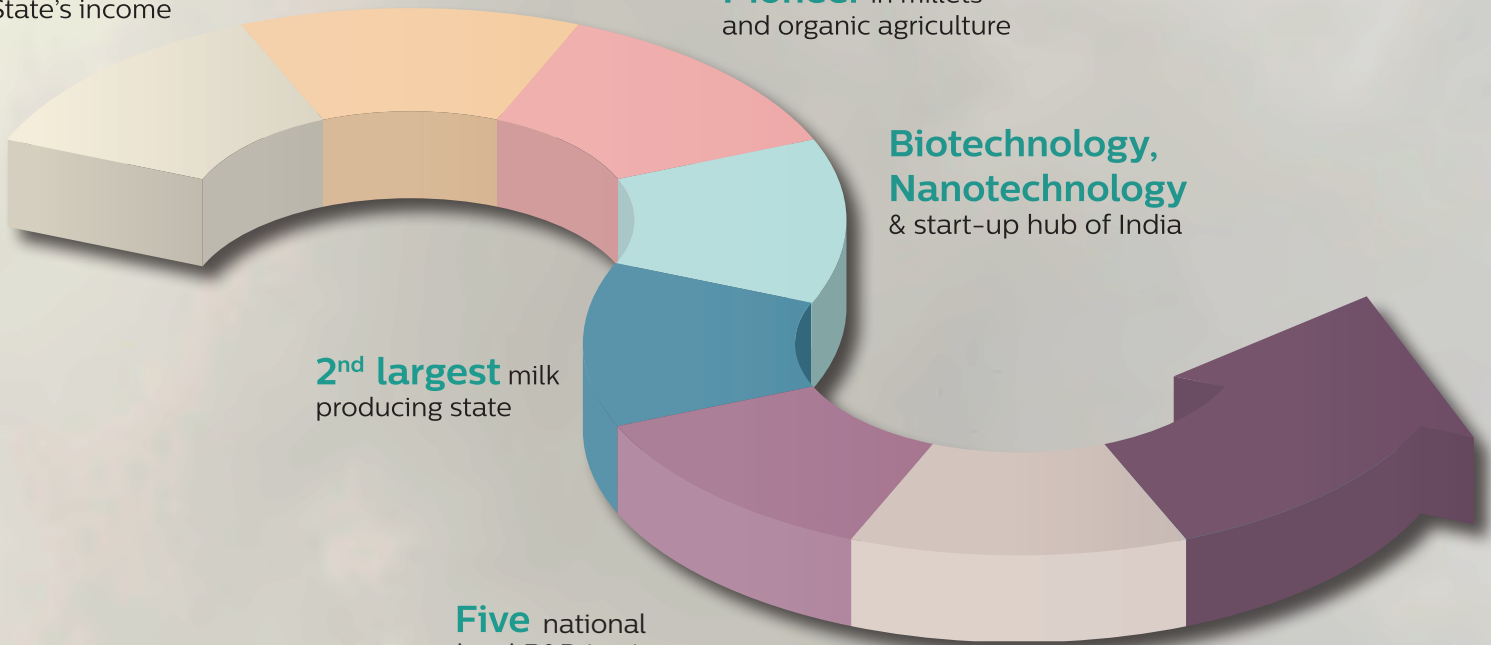

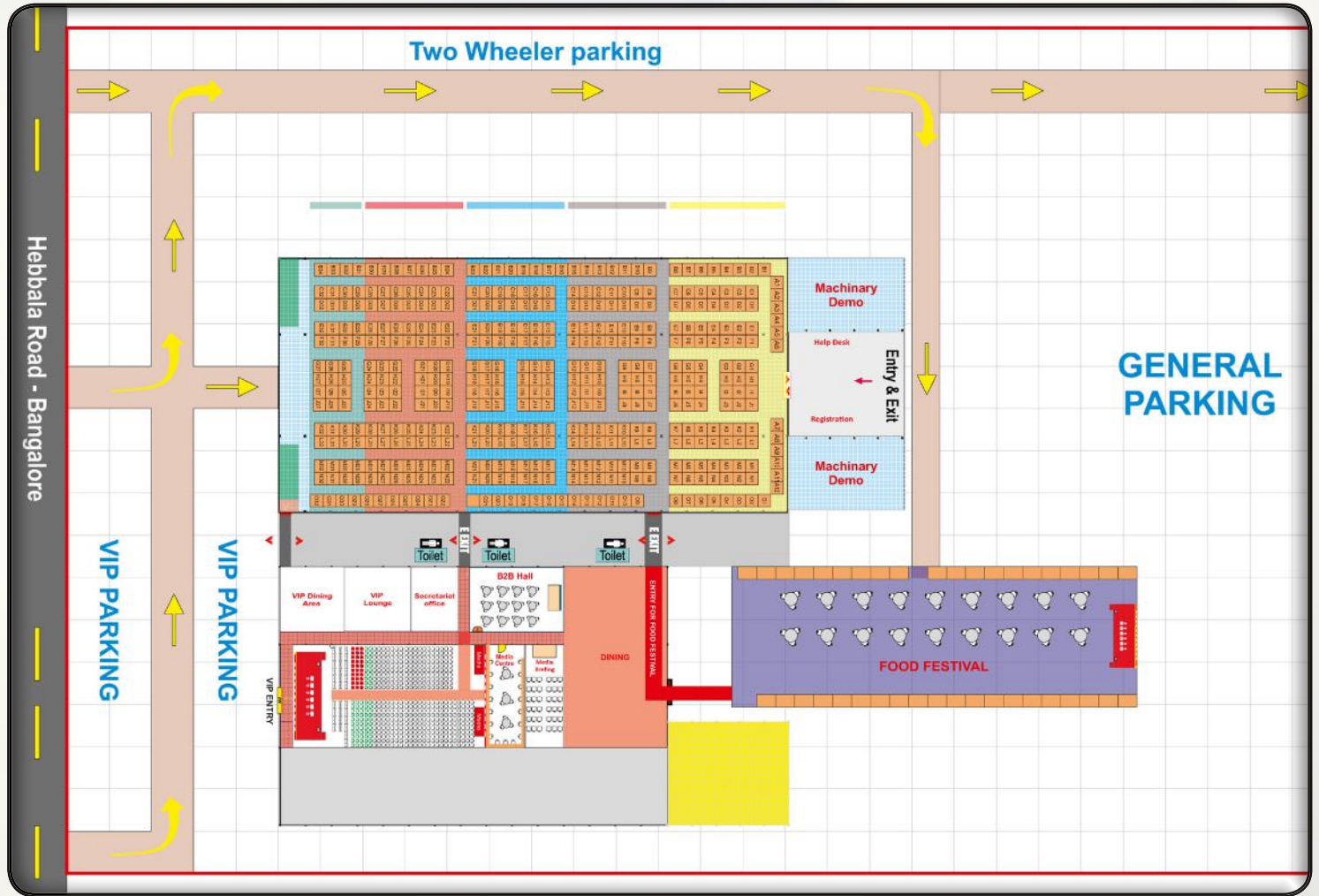
Multi Cultural Food Festival
