Manufacturer of super-premium whiskies and gins

James Bay Distillers, Ltd. produces super-premium whiskies and gins from their distillery at Paine Field airport in Everett, WA, north of Seattle. The company focuses on best-quality spirits meant to be consumed “neat” or with ice, and not requiring a mixer. Each of their spirits also works well in traditional or new and adventurous cocktails. Their market focus is two-fold: young professionals who value quality products and enjoy experiencing new spirits, and established consumers who understand and seek the value of luxury spirits.

The company uses local, organic, and sustainable ingredients whenever available. For example, **Lochside Summer Gin No. 5** uses a cold infusion of organic kumquat from California, with added mandarin, tangerine and orange blossom. The company’s

Gintrigue Barrel-finished Gin is aged a minimum of 6-months in 53-gallon oak barrels which held bourbon (4 years) and French cognac (7 years).

The company was formed as a C-corporation in 2014 and after exploration of locations in the United States and Canada, the distillery established its site in January 2018. The company holds U.S. Federal, Washington State and local permits. Their spirits have earned gold-, silver- and bronze-awards from these and other competitions: California Distillers, American Distilling Institute, Denver International Spirits Competition, Distilled San Diego and John Barleycorn Awards of Texas.



The company sells direct to consumers at the distillery and online, and through various wholesale and distributor agreements.

Company founders' background includes work at other distilleries in the U.S. and Canada, and over 14-years work abroad, primarily in Europe and the Middle East.
