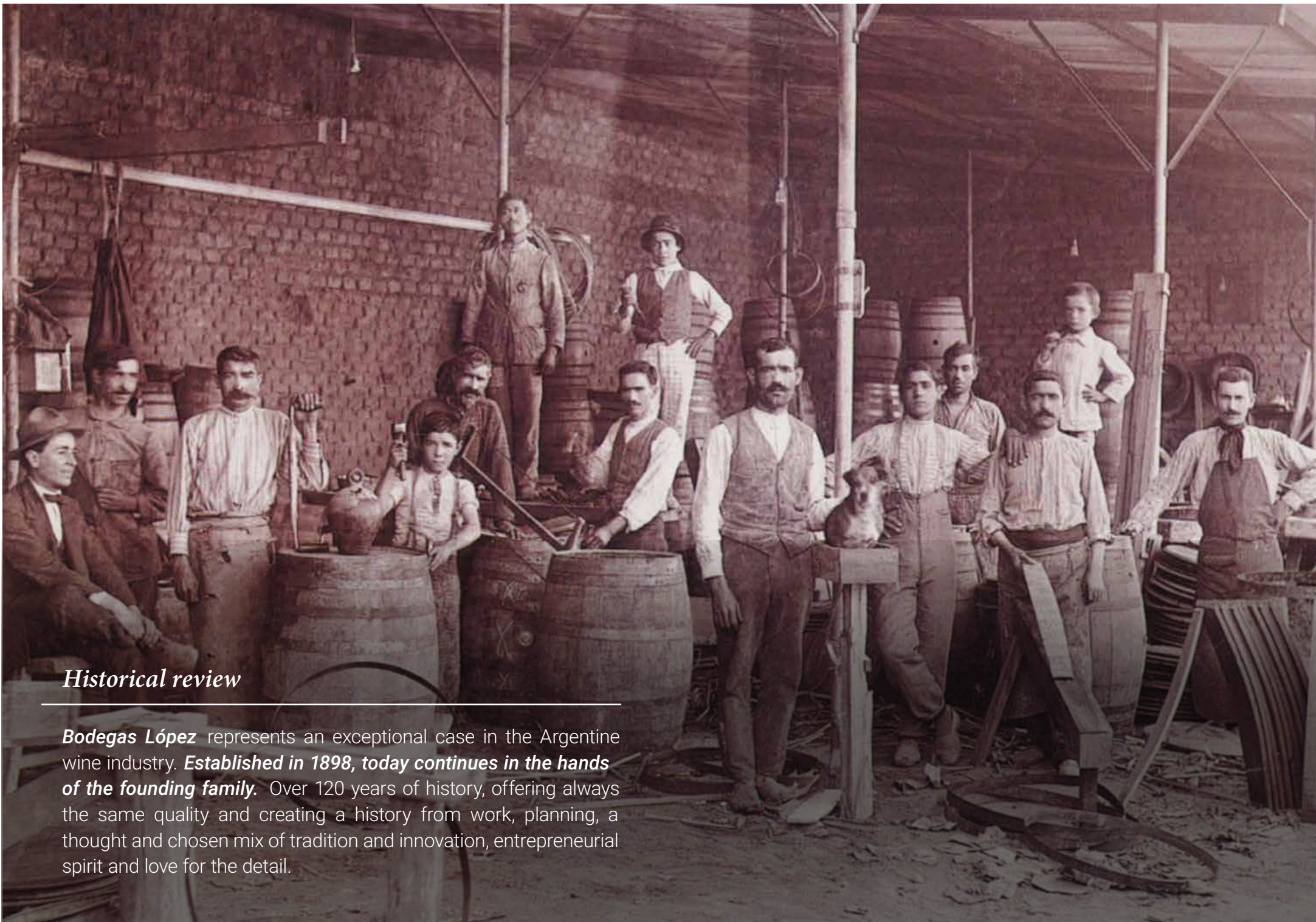

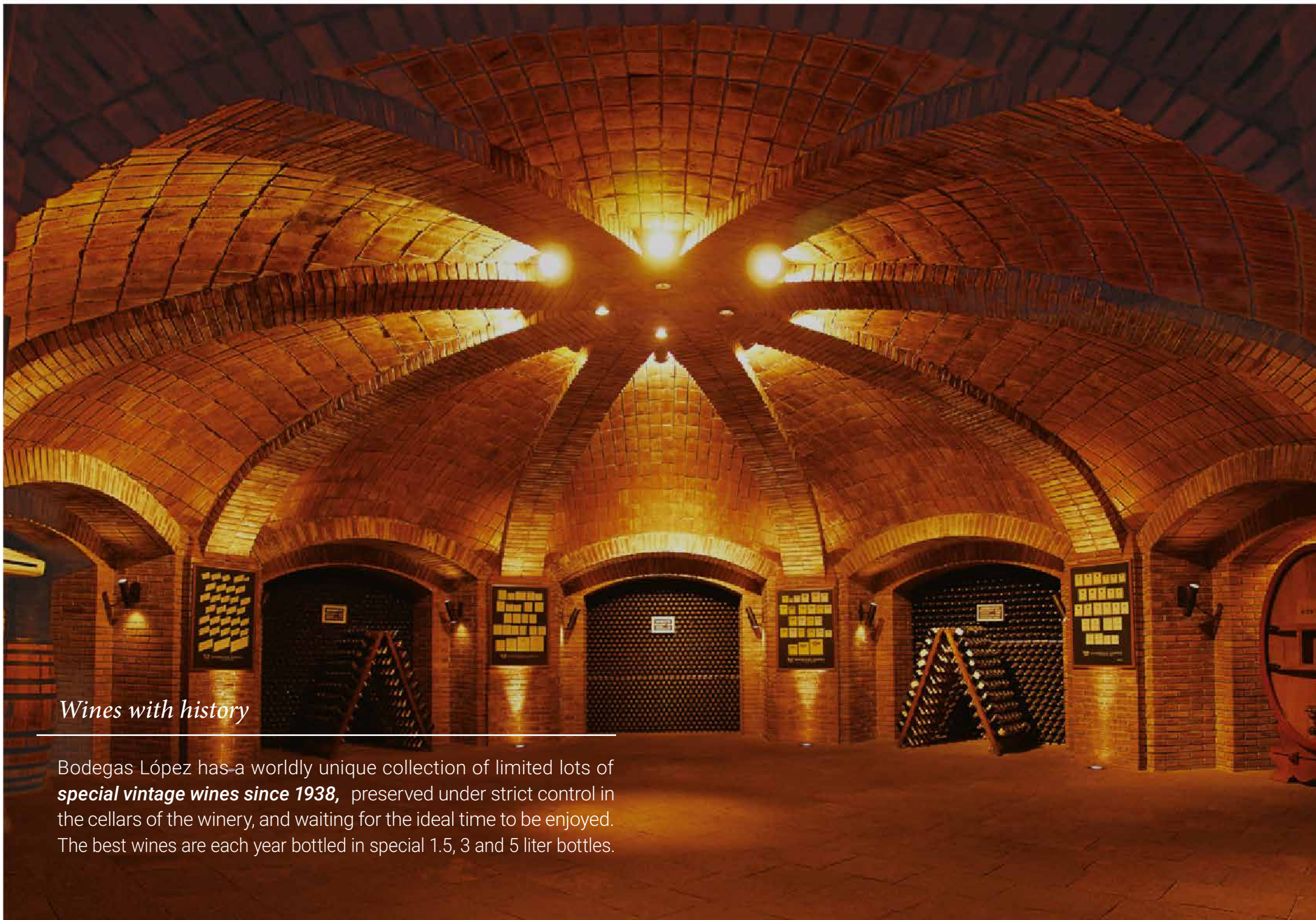

## *The Wines and its Winemaking*

---

Bodegas López has been producing wines from the best regions of Mendoza province in Argentina for more than 120 years. Its winemaking style is a true reflection of **tradition and know-how**; use of oak casks, long periods of bottle stowage, elegant and balanced wines, and mostly classic blends from the Bordeaux region in France. The Winery has an important reserve of red wines with great aging potential, aged in French oak casks of 5,000 to 35,000 liters and white wines preserved at low temperatures in epoxy coated concrete pools and stainless steel tanks.



### *Wines with history*

Bodegas López has a worldly unique collection of limited lots of **special vintage wines since 1938**, preserved under strict control in the cellars of the winery, and waiting for the ideal time to be enjoyed. The best wines are each year bottled in special 1.5, 3 and 5 liter bottles.



## *The Vineyards*

---

Bodegas López owns **1.100 hectares of vineyards** located in the best areas of Mendoza (Cruz de Piedra and Lunlunta in Maipú, Agrelo in Luján de Cuyo, and Tupungato, in the Uco Valley). ***Its oldest vineyards date back to 1917.***



Bodegas Lopez works with a traditional vineyard management, with soil tillage to destroy weeds, aerate the land and conserve moisture. These tasks are done with subsoilers, chisels, plows, discs, harrows and manual and mechanical inter-row weeding machines. The pruning system used is Double Guyot, which allows for the useful life of the plant to be extended, and it is worked with bud wrapping, for breaking the dominance in the plants. The irrigation system is by furrows (and in some cases with concrete cimanco) and dripping. Pest control management is practically organic.

Traditional European varieties are cultivated, such as ***Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese, Pinot Noir, Syrah, Chardonnay, Semillón, Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin Blanc.***

Faithful to its tradition, Bodegas López relies on a formula as simple as it is difficult to emulate:

***"The excellence of its wines, fruit of a style cultivated by four generations, The López Style".***



## Federico López

---

A tribute to **Don Federico López**, son of the winery's founder and ideologist of the fine and aged wines of Bodegas López, with all the love of his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. A classic Bordeaux assemblage of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes, aged for 15 years and made only in exceptional vintages.



# MONTCHENOT

---

The Montchenot family of wines was **born in 1956**, after a trip by Jose Federico López to the wine regions of France, where he visited a small town called Montchenot, in Reims, and returned convinced of the need of producing quality and aging wines in Argentina.

Portfolio: 20, 15 and 10 years old, Petit Montchenot and Chenin Blanc.

Sparklings: Brut Nature, Nature, Extra Brut and Rosé.



# Chateau Vieux

---

Chateau Vieux wines honor the ancient French castles where high-end wines were first made. These wines represent tradition and know-how at its best. Released to the market in 1934, **they were the first Premium Wines of Bodegas López**. They are gastronomic, versatile, softened by the passage of time, and with tertiary aromas and flavors.

Portfolio: Red Blend, Malbec, Chardonnay and Chardonnay Oak



# CASONA LOPEZ

---

Casona López wines pay tribute to the family's old Casona (house), which housed **four generations, a great family history and the legacy of a lineage of winemakers.**

Portfolio: Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Chardonnay.



# RINCÓN FAMOSO

## *Rincón Famoso*

### VINO HISTÓRICO

---

***Rincón Famoso*** ("**Famous Corner**"), comes from a unique corner of our vineyards, which offers grapes of exceptional quality.

We also highlight other corners in our winery: The Corner of "know-how", where our winemakers with their experience and wisdom give this wine a special spirit.

The Corner of "storage", where the bottles calmly wait, so that time does its job.

The Corner of "history", where our family, generation after generation, has left its unmistakable mark Rincón Famoso: today's wine, "always".

Portfolio: Sangiovese - Malbec - Merlot, Chardonnay - Chenin Blanc and Rosé - Malbec - Pinot Noir



# LOPEZ

---

*The classic Argentine wine* that has always carried the surname of the founding family and has led the Winery's destiny for more than 120 years.

Portfolio: Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Semillón, Sauvignon Blanc and Dulce Natural.

Sparklings: Extra Brut, Brut, Demi Sec and Sweet.



# Traful

---

*Traful is a word of Mapuche* origin that means union. The personality of this name also responds to a curious and restless, dreamy and idealistic spirit of an expressive nature. The place where the grapes that give rise to these wines come from connects us with nature and inspires us to develop blends and varietals full of life and color.

Portfolio: Red Blend, White Blend, Malbec, Chardonnay-Semillón and Sweet.



# VASCO VIEJO

---

*Vasco Viejo*, the main actor of the Argentine table since 1950, is a tradition that has been renewed. Classic wines to enjoy every day. Young, fresh and fruity, made with grapes from Luján de Cuyo and Maipú, Mendoza, Argentina.


Portfolio: Red Blend, White Blend and Malbec.
