Why LOOPE?

LOOPE is more than just furniture - it's a thoughtful system that redefines consumption. The friendly, simple, and timeless forms ensure longevity while staying relevant, helping to reduce excessive consumerism. Most importantly, the material can be recycled multiple times.

After five years, customers can return their furniture, and we'll transform it into a new product. This way, we extend its life and reduce plastic production.

Technology and material

Technology and material innovation are at the heart of LOOPE, offering endless possibilities. Plastic is often controversial, but our project proves that it can be used responsibly. We manufacture furniture from pre-consumer recycled polyethylene, ready to be recycled repeatedly under controlled conditions. Sourced from other products made in our factory in Poland, this material returns to circulation in the form of durable furniture, instead of ending up as waste.

With full control over the recycling process, we ensure the polyethylene remains uncontaminated and, under controlled conditions, retains its key properties. This exceptional material is resistant to weather, scratches, breaks, and impacts. It's flexible, soft, yet incredibly durable extending the life of each piece.

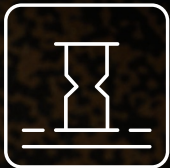
