TERMS OF REFERENCE

INDONESIA–KOREA NETWORKING DAY: EXPANDING BILATERAL ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP

I. EVENT OVERVIEW

Indonesia and the Republic of Korea share a long-standing history of diplomatic relations, built upon strong political stability, economic collaboration, cultural exchange, and enduring people-to-people ties. Over the decades, both nations have consistently demonstrated their commitment to advancing mutual interests and fostering regional stability.

A significant milestone in this relationship was the establishment of the Special Strategic Partnership in 2017, which broadened the scope of cooperation across multiple sectors. This partnership reflects the high level of trust and dedication between the two countries, laying a solid foundation for nurturing and expanding bilateral cooperation in the years ahead.

In 2023, economic cooperation reached a new level with the implementation of the Indonesia–Korea Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (IK-CEPA). This agreement serves as a key mechanism to further strengthen bilateral economic ties such as promoting the creation of a sustainable supply chain. Indonesia contributes its vast human capital and abundant natural resources, while Korea brings advanced technology and financial capacity. Together, these complementary strengths are expected to drive mutually beneficial growth, enhance resilience, and open new avenues for trade and investment collaboration.

Within this broader framework, Trade Expo Indonesia (TEI) has emerged as a flagship platform showcasing Indonesia’s diverse products to the world. TEI has consistently attracted strong participation from Korean enterprises, underscoring Korea’s role as one of Indonesia’s most important economic partners. The success of the Korean Business Mission to the 40th TEI, held on 16–19 October 2025, demonstrated the depth of interest and commitment of Korean companies in exploring Indonesia’s as a strategic source of production and collaboration.

Against this backdrop, the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Seoul, together with the Indonesia Trade Promotion Center in Busan, is organizing **the Indonesia–Korea Networking Day: Expanding Bilateral Economic Partnership** to take place at:
